

Call for Papers

The Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA) will host an Econ Summit on Housing Supply and Equity at the Agency's headquarters in Washington, DC on Wednesday, May 28, 2025.

The Agency welcomes and encourages the submission of a broad range of research work. Submissions can be on topics related to housing supply, such as residential zoning, construction costs, innovation, homebuilding, house prices, and rental and rural markets; and/or topics related to social equity, such as the homeownership gap, first-time homebuyers and minorities, redevelopment, housing inequality, migration, gentrification, affordability, and rural housing.

Papers are welcome from, but are not limited to, the fields of economics, real estate studies, and finance.

The deadline for submissions is 5:00 PMET on **Friday, November 29, 2024**. Decisions regarding accepted papers will be communicated by early February.

Authors may submit complete papers or detailed abstracts that include preliminary results and a disclosure statement, following the <u>AEA disclosure policy</u>. The cover page of each submission must include the paper title, abstract, authors, affiliations, and contact information including email address(es).
