In addition, we are also a member of the National Community Reinvestment Coalition (NCRC). Delaware has benefitted greatly from affordable housing goals. Between 2003 and 2012, 94, 208 Del aware househol ds received loans financed through the affordable housing goals, 28 percent of all households benefited from the affordable housing goals and 71 percent of low- and moderate-income Delaware households benefited from these goals. We firmly believe that the affordable housing goals are far too important to preserving and building the wealth of working-class people to allow regulatory policies to marginalize or minimize their effect. We believe that the final 2015-2017 Enterprises Housing Goals rule can be strengthened by addressing NCRCs concerns and adopting the coalitions recommendations.
