On November 2, 2016, staff from the Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA), the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC), the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System (FRB), the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC), and the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) met with representatives from the Securities Industry and Financial Markets Association (SIFMA), Barclays, the Bank of New York Mellon (BNY Mellon), Clearly Gottlieb Steen & Hamilton LLP (Cleary Gottlieb), Davis Polk & Wardwell LLP (Davis Polk), Fidelity, Goldman Sachs Bank USA (Goldman Sachs), Janney Montgomery Scott LLC (Janney), JP Morgan Chase, Morgan Stanley, Nomura Holding America Inc. (Nomura), Schwab, TD Ameritrade, and U.S. Bank. The representatives shared their views on the proposed Incentive-Based Compensation Arrangements rule.
