By using PACE financing, property owners can receive money up-front to pay for these improvements and then pay for the upgrades in small increments that are added to their property taxes over an extended period of time.

Unfortunately, in 2010, the Federal Housing Finance Agency halted PACE programs, preventing hundreds of communities across the country from taking advantage of existing and developing programs.
