I am writing to request a meeting out of concern for the proposed guidance relating to Private Transfer Fee Covenants of the Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA), issued on August 16, 2010 (N.2010-N-11). This request is on behalf of an ad-hoc coalition of affordable housing, conservation, historic preservation, homeowner organizations, community infrastructure and environmental groups.
