Dear Mr. DeMarco:

I write on behalf of the Seward Park Cooperative, located at 413 Grand Street, New York, New York, 10002. We strongly disagree with the above captioned proposal which we consider wrong ard harmful to housing communities and their residents. The transfer fees we collect are used to fund needed capital improvements to our buildings and to replace aging building systems. Without transfer fees, our Board would have to substantially increase monthly carrying charges in order to maintain our building. This will inflict financial hardship on our shareholders and could result in defaults, displacement for individuals and, a poorer quality of life. We urge the FHFA to protect the right of housing cooperatives and condominiums to preserve affordability by continuing to collect transfer fees.
