Ladies & Gentlemen,

The proposed rule to ban financing of manufactured housing that is personal property (in parks) is a direct affront to senior housing in Oregon. Of the 66,000 such housing units in Oregon, and the 6400 which I have considerable knowledge of here in Clackamas County, between 85% and 95% are filled with seniors on limited income. In the case of our community, it is one third senior women. These people need and deserve access to financing as congress directed.

Manufactured housing is the affordable housing option in most of the country and to deny it access to financing by Freddie and Fannie is to add directly to the cost to seniors.
