My manufactured home is located in Brookfield Meadows in Brookfield Massachusetts. It sits upon land that is leased from the park owners. I do not own the land.

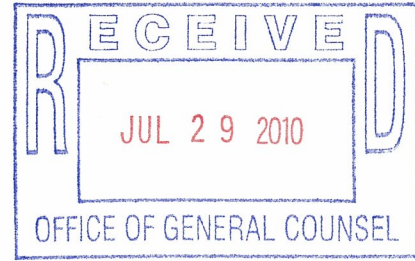
I believe there are over 10 million US citizens, elderly and /or lower income families currently living in leased-land manufactured housing.

I hope you reconsider RIN 2590-AA27.

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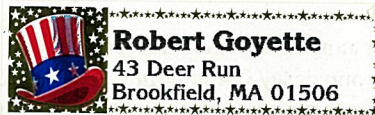
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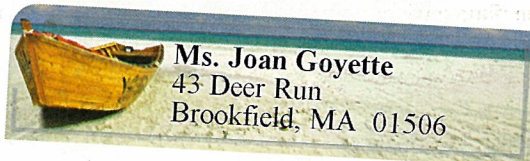
